



# SILVER POINT BEACH CLUB DAY CAMP

## DATES

Camp will begin on **Tuesday, June 30th** and will run until **Friday, August 14<sup>th</sup> 2026**.  
*There is no camp on Friday, July 3rd.*

## HOURS

Drop off campers is between 10:50-11:00 AM. Activities begin **promptly at 11.00 AM**.  
Afternoon line-up (including snack) is from 3:40 - 4:00 pm. **Please pick up your child by 4:00 PM.**

**UPPER CAMP** G6/7, Senior Boys, Senior Girls is in the **REC ROOM**

On a "rainy day" the schedule will be altered. If you wish to pick up your child early, please come to your child's rainy day location. Drop off on a rainy day will be the same location as pick up.  
**Camp will only be closed if the beach club closes and you will be notified on our social media pages.**

## EARLY DISMISSAL

**If you are picking your child up early:**

1. Please inform the camphouse office, before the start of the camp day, of the time you would like to pick up your child. Your child will be waiting in the camp office for you.
2. If you want to pick up your child early from camp, and you have not notified the office beforehand, either:
  - a. sign out your child directly from the senior counselor or
  - b. report to the Camphouse Office and your child will be retrieved for you.

## **FEE**

Fee (\$2200) includes a full program, all supplies and materials, a daily snack, camp t-shirts, camp apparel, and all special programs.

A check covering the full amount must accompany your completed registration form **by June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026**. A late fee of \$50 will be applied to the tuition for registration forms received after June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026. Enrollment is limited!

## **GUESTS**

Guest fee is \$80 per day. Please contact the management office for more information.

## **FACILITIES**

Located on the grounds of Silver Point Beach Club, our day camp features a spacious, air-conditioned camphouse; two beautiful swimming pools; two air-conditioned arts and crafts rooms; a recreation room; a large ballfield; three full-court basketball courts; two Ga Ga courts; tennis and pickleball courts; a shed for drama and music; a game room; and a dedicated Lower Camp area. The Lower Camp area includes a playground, two indoor air-conditioned playrooms, and three tented areas.

## **STAFF**

At Silver Point Beach Club Day Camp, our dedicated staff and well-structured program provide every child with the opportunity to learn, explore, and grow. With an approximate camper-to-staff ratio of 3:1, many of our counselors are returning team members who offer both experience and a strong sense of continuity within our camp community.

- Age 14 – Camper or Volunteer C.I.T. (Counselor in Training)
- Age 15 – C.I.T. (Counselor in Training)
- Age 16 – Junior Counselor
- Age 17 – Counselor
- Age 18 and up – Senior Counselor

Each group will be supervised by a Division Head (Supervisor), two Senior Counselors, and one or more Counselors, Junior Counselors, and C.I.T.s. Group sizes will range from 10 to 18 campers.

## GROUP ASSIGNMENTS

Campers in Middle and Upper Camp will be assigned groups based on their gender and the school grade they will be attending in September 2026. Lower Camp groups will be designated based on the year the camper was born.

- Lower Camp (going into Nursery, Pre-K, or Kindergarten) ages 3-5  
**Campers MUST be potty-trained**
- Middle Camp (going into 1<sup>st</sup> grade through 4<sup>th</sup> grade) ages 6-9
- Upper Camp (going into 5<sup>th</sup> grade through 9<sup>th</sup> grade) ages 10-14

## LUNCH INFORMATION

Lunch will be collected at **11:00 a.m.** and refrigerated until each camper's scheduled lunch period. Please send lunch in a **labeled paper bag only** (including your child's name and group). Campers should not bring lunch from the Beach Club cafeteria or bring money for hot lunch. **For the safety of all campers, please do not include peanuts/treenuts or other nut products in lunches.**

On **Wednesdays and Fridays**, families may order lunch for their child from the beach club cafeteria. Instructions for placing an order will be provided for you. All orders must be submitted **the day before**, and lunches will be delivered directly to camp. Please note that all purchases are final.

## POOL INFORMATION

Every child will have the opportunity to swim daily.

**LOWER CAMP: Kiddie Pool ONLY**

**MIDDLE CAMP/UPPER CAMP: Main Pool**

On the first day of camp, all campers in Middle and Upper Camp will be evaluated by a WSI-certified lifeguard to determine their swim level and the appropriate area for swimming in the main pool. Campers will have the opportunity to be retested weekly to assess readiness for the deep end. Please note that all swim-level decisions are made at the discretion of the head lifeguard.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

- If your child has a **birthday** during the camp season and you would like to celebrate in camp, please speak with the counselors directly so that they can arrange the celebration during the lunch period. Just a reminder that any food item must be prepackaged to identify any allergens.

## DAILY REMINDERS

## **BOARD OF HEALTH REGULATIONS**

To comply with Board of Health regulations, **all campers must have a completed medical form on file in the camphouse office. Campers cannot attend camp without this form.** Please also notify the directors of any special medical conditions or allergies your child may have. Groups are organized to meet the required counselor-to-camper ratios.

## **EMERGENCY RELEASE FORM**

An emergency release form must be on file at the camphouse. This form helps us determine who is authorized to pick up your child and whether your child may be released without a signature. **Please note that your child will not be released to anyone not listed on the form.**

## **TIPPING**

While tipping is completely voluntary, please understand that counselors rely, in part, on the generosity and appreciation of families to supplement their salaries. There will be two designated tipping days during the camp season.
